



Weekly Incident Summary March 16-22, 2020



Monday, March 16, 2020

00:32 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an alarm activation on Dr Moore Crt in Acton. On scene fire staff entered the home and found a smoke alarm on the main level with batteries low. Fire staff installed new batteries and tested the alarm with no further problems.

11:39 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an alarm activation on Sargent Rd. On scene fire staff found a contractor performing repairs to the furnace, which resulted in the alarm activating.

22:28 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an ambulance assist on Caseley Dr. Peel Regional Paramedics were on scene upon arrival. Fire staff assisted with patient care and cleared the scene.

Tuesday, March 17, 2020

20:13 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an unknown odour on Harrop Ave. On scene fire staff entered the home and directed to the second floor where a slight smell of smoke was noticeable. After investigating fire staff found a large collection of dust on the bathroom fan. The power was disconnected to the fan and the homeowner will replace.

02:09 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an alarm activation on Morningside Dr. On scene fire staff met with the homeowner who directed staff to the second floor where a smoke alarm was chirping. The detector was showing a fault. The alarm was replaced with no further concerns.

18:36 Hours – Fire fighters responded to the report of a three-vehicle motor vehicle collision in the area of Trafalgar Rd & Steeles Ave. On scene fire staff were advised they were not required.

Thursday, March 19, 2020

18:36 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an alarm activation on Queen St E in Acton. On scene fire staff were advised that the alarm was activated by burnt cooking in one of the units. Fire staff entered the building and confirmed the alarm. The alarm was re-set with no further concerns.

19:28 Hours – Fire fighters responded to an ambulance assist on Elgin St. Halton Regional Police and Halton Regional Paramedics were on scene upon arrival. Fire staff assisted with patient care and cleared the scene.

Friday, March 20, 2020
