



## NEW: on-street parking changes

September 30, 2019

Town Council approved an extension for on-street parking. The change extends the allowable time that residents can park on a street by one hour, from 5 to 6 hours.

Another change approved by Council was to remove parking limits for individuals displaying an accessible parking permit.

The motion was brought forward by Councillor Moya Johnson and seconded by Councillor Fogal. The vote to amend the parking by-law was unanimous. The change goes into effect September 30.

Note: on-street parking is not available between 2 and 6 a.m. during the winter control ban which runs from November 15 to April 15. The ban prohibits all on-street parking to ensure access for snow clearing vehicles.

### ***Did you know:***

- The Town of Halton Hills receives authority for ticketing through the Provincial Offences Act.
- The parking limit change requires the Town to amend the Uniform Traffic Control By-law by seeking approval from the Office of the Attorney General.
- The Town will undertake a comprehensive parking study to be completed in 2020.
