RETAIL SALE OF PET

25.1 The issuing of a Pet Care and Breeding Service Establishment licence shall be subject to an inspection by the Town, and may be subject to an inspection by the Regional Municipality of Halton Health Department.

25.2 Every Licensee of a pet shop shall ensure that:

25.2.1 the Premises to be used are maintained in a clean, sanitary condition, well-ventilated, and free of any offensive odours;

25.2.2 cages, containers, enclosures, or tanks used to house and display animals, birds, fish or reptiles are sufficient in size and dimensions to permit the animal to stand to its normal full height, turn around, and lie down in a fully extended position, and structurally sound;

25.2.3 cages or containers are cleaned daily and all holding areas for dogs and cats are disinfected daily;

25.2.4 every animal is provided with adequate food and potable water at all times; and

25.2.5 temperatures in the living quarters of every animal, bird, fish, or reptile are maintained appropriate for the health of the species.

25.3 No Licensee of a pet shop shall knowingly sell, offer or keep for sale either in connection with the licensed pet shop, or in connection with any other business operation:

25.3.1 any sick, diseased, or unhealthy animal, bird, fish or reptile which exhibits signs of an infectious disease, including distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, rabies, or any other deficiency including rickets, malnutrition, parasites, or any abnormality that might affect the health of the animal; and

25.3.2 any exotic animal as defined in the Town's Responsible Pet Owner's By-law.

25.4 Every Licensee of a pet shop shall seek treatment by a qualified Person for any injured, sick, diseased, or dying animal, bird, fish or reptile kept for sale.

25.5 No Licensee of a pet shop shall sell a dog or cat without providing a dated receipt describing the animal and a current certificate of health issued by a veterinarian to the consumer.

25.6 Every Licensee of a pet shop shall maintain a register or a computer database to store the details of the purchase of each dog or cat indicating the name and address of the licensee's supplier, a full description of the dog or cat including gender, colour, breed, or cross-breed, locations of any markings, etc., and the date of each transaction for the term of the licence and available for inspection by an Officer upon request.

CANINE BOARDING AND BREEDING ESTABLISHMENTS- KENNELS

- 25.7 Every applicant or Licensee of a Canine Boarding and Breeding Establishment shall:
- 25.7.1 submit a site plan indicating the location of all buildings;
 - 25.7.2 submit a Certificate of Registration or certified extract with the Canadian Kennel Club or other association incorporated under the Animal Pedigree Act (Canada) indicating that all dogs kept, bred, and raised in the kennel are so registered or eligible to be registered; and
 - 25.7.3 allow an inspection of the Premises by the Regional Municipality of Halton Health Department.
- 25.8 No Licensee shall operate or maintain a Canine Boarding Establishment that:
- 25.8.1 is closer than thirty (30) metres from any property line;
 - 25.8.2 is attached to a dwelling unit or any other building used for human habitation;
 - 25.8.3 does not have a floor of concrete or other impermeable material with a drain opening constructed as a plumbing fixture;
 - 25.8.4 does not have windows that can be opened for proper ventilation;
 - 25.8.5 does not have adequately sized cages to allow the dog to extend its legs to their full extent, stand or sit, turn around, or lie down in a fully extended position;
 - 25.8.6 does not have cages that are constructed solely of metal, wire, or impermeable concrete block; and
 - 25.8.7 does not have an outside area for use by dogs enclosed with a solid board fence of a minimum height of one (1) metre, which shall be deemed part of the building for the purpose of this by-law.
 - 25.8.8 Every Licensee of a Canine Boarding and Breeding Establishment shall:
 - 25.8.9 thoroughly clean the floor of the Canine Boarding and Breeding Establishment on a daily basis;
 - 25.8.10 maintain the Premises in a sanitary, well-ventilated, clean condition, and free from offensive odours;
 - 25.8.11 keep all dogs in a clean and healthy condition free from vermin and disease;
 - 25.8.12 provide every dog with adequate food and potable water at all times; and
 - 25.8.13 provide every dog with sanitary, well ventilated, naturally lighted quarters kept at a healthy temperature at all times.
