

# CEMETERIES

Town of Halton Hills currently operates and maintains Greenwood Cemetery (Georgetown), Fairview Cemetery (Acton) and Hillcrest Cemetery (Norval). The Town also preserves seven inactive heritage cemeteries, rich in historical significance that date back to 1830.

### Greenwood Cemetery

### Fairview Cemetery

20 Cobblehill Road, Acton  
Main St. S (Hwy 25) & Cobblehill Rd.  
Two blocks South of Mill St. (Hwy 7)

### Hillcrest Cemetery

Winston Churchill Boulevard and Tenth Sideroad, Norval

## Cemeteries Regulations and By-law

Cemetery use is controlled by Municipal By-law 2012-0082, available at [www.haltonhills.ca/cemeteries](http://www.haltonhills.ca/cemeteries). Of note are the following provisions:

- Wreaths must follow the season and be kept in good condition
- Pets are not permitted in the cemetery
- Vehicle speed is limited to 10 km/hour

### By-law Terminology

To assist with the language used in the Cemeteries By-law, the following are definitions of key components:

- A cemetery lot is a specific area of land that has been designated for the interment of human remains;
- A plot is two or more lots sold as a unit;
- An interment refers to placing human remains in a lot, plot or columbarium niche;
- A single lot may contain one full interment with up to three cremation interments;
- A columbarium is a solid granite structure with niches for the interment of up to four urns or cremated remains in each niche.
