Town of Halton Hills currently operates and maintains Greenwood Cemetery (Georgetown), Fairview Cemetery (Acton) and Hillcrest Cemetery (Norval). The Town also preserves seven inactive heritage cemeteries, rich in historical significance that date back to 1830.

Cemeteries Regulations

Cemetery use is controlled by Municipal By-law and includes the following provisions:

- Wreaths must follow the season and be kept in good condition
- Pets are not permitted in the cemetery
- Vehicle speed is limited to 10 km/hour

Cemeteries By-Law

To assist with the language used in the Cemetery By-Law, staff offer the following definitions of key components:

- A cemetery lot is a specific area of land that has been designated for the interment of human remains;
- A plot is two or more lots sold as a unit;
- An interment refers to placing human remains in a lot, plot or columbarium niche;
- A single lot may contain one full interment with up to three cremation interments;
- A columbarium is a solid granite structure with niches for the interment of up to four urns or cremated remains in each niche.

Lot or Plot Planting

Dwarf and ornamental trees must be approved by Town staff and meet the following criteria:

- Placed within the monument line
- Reach a maximum height of 4 ft. (1.2 m)
- Within the limit of the lot or plot when fully grown
- Be free of thorns or hazards

Examples of acceptable plants:

Evergreen Plants: Dwarf Balsam, Dwarf Alberta Spruce, Little Champion Cedar, Bennett Dwarf Hemlock, Emerald Gaitay Euonymus, Japanese Pieris.

Shrubs: Pygmy Pea Shrub, Potentilla, Gold Mound Spirea, Minuet Weigela, Silver Edged Dogwood, Corkscrew Hazel.

Greenwood Cemetery Capacity

Ground lots at Greenwood Cemetery are nearing capacity. A limited selection of lots are available for those in immediate need of an interment. No pre-need sales of lots are available in Greenwood Cemetery at this time.

The scattering Reflection Garden and columbarium niches provide additional interment options for cremations. Please contact the Cemetery Coordinator at 905-873-2601 ext. 2281 for more information.
