## REGISTERED PROGRAMS for YOUNG KIDS

### Baby Tales

Music, rhythm, rhymes and puppets for babies 0 – 23 months. One child per adult recommended.

### Tales for Twos

Picture books, felt board stories, music and puppets for you and your two-year-old (24-35 months). One child per adult recommended.

### KinderPrep

A thirty-minute program that helps prepare children for Kindergarten including stories, music and puppets as well as early-learning concepts. 3-5 year olds attend on their own with adults remaining in the building.

### Lego Robotics

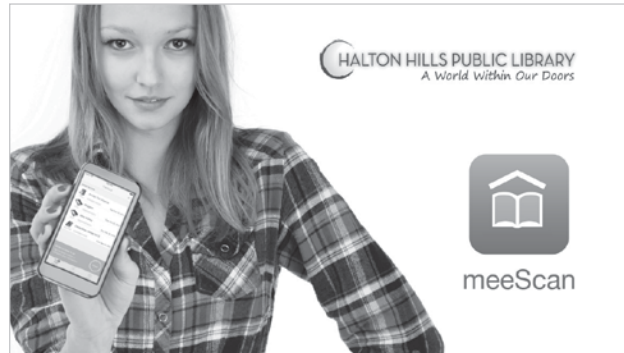
