## How to Book a Town Recreational Facility

2. Sign permit & provide deposit
3. Submit necessary documentation
4. Provide final payment

## Rental Minimums

Please note there may be one to three hour minimums in effect when renting some facility types and/or locations.

## Non-Resident Surcharge

A non-resident surcharge will be applied to rental fees for out-of-town individuals and businesses.

## Arena Surcharge

The arena surcharge contributes to funding for construction of Halton Hills' new arena facilities. The Arena Hourly Surcharge applies to all users of the arenas and the various facilities within and continues until approximately 2022 when the debt is to be retired.
